This application has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to inspect the original answer-sheets of two papers i.e. Law of Contracts and torts as well as Elementary General Science.

Handwritten notes and signatures on the left margin, including dates like 10/3/08 and 11/3/08, and some illegible text.

Petitioner appeared in the examination conducted by the Bihar Public Service Commission for appointment to the post of Civil Judge, ~~Class II~~. On the basis of the marks obtained by him in the written examination, he was called for viva voce test but ultimately he has not been selected. According to him, he had performed well in the Law of Contracts and torts and Elementary General Science but he has not been awarded marks as expected by him. Accordingly his prayer is for issuance of a direction to the respondent to permit inspection of the answer-sheets of the aforesaid two papers.

When questioned as to which provision entitles the petitioner to inspect the answer-sheets, Mr. Ajit Kumar
