University/Educational Institutions/ Organization/Board/Council/ Commission or by any other Government undertaking organization either indefinitely or for a particular period of time during the last 3 years as on day of bidding.</p> <p>In case any documents contradicting the above clause are found by the Commission, the Commission reserves the right to immediately reject the Bid.</p>	<p>We seek clarification regarding the requirement for the Undertaking to be submitted on a Notary Affidavit of INR 1000 and the Annexure -III Self-Declaration - Non-Blacklisting to be provided on the bidder's letterhead. As per the bid document, it is stated that both the affidavit and the self-declaration are required. However, we would like to understand whether the Notary Affidavit on INR 1000 stamp and the Annexure -III Self-Declaration on the bidder's letterhead should be provided separately or if you are requesting only one of these formats. Specifically, if both documents are required: Should the Notary Affidavit be provided on the INR 1000 stamp paper in addition to the self-declaration on the letterhead, or can the Self-Declaration on the letterhead be submitted instead of the INR 1000 stamp paper affidavit? In case both are mandatory, we request confirmation that we need to submit both the affidavit and the self-declaration as per the bid requirements.
